Homework

Weekly spellings will be sent out and these will be tested on a Friday. Spelling shed can be used to practise spellings. If you have lost the login, please speak to a member of the Year 6 team who will be happy to get a new one for you. Times Tables Rock Stars can be used to practise times tables. Your child will also be sent home with weekly homework. Our school have ordered GPS books for your children to use for their SATs revision. When these arrive, we will direct the children to the correct page to complete for the week as part of their homework. This will be a consolidation of what they have learnt in school that week.

<u>PE kit</u>

For PE children should wear a white or red t-shirt with black or red shorts. For colder weather black joggers or leggings can be worn. Children should also wear their red school jumper or red school Hoody. No other tracksuits are allowed on PE days. Children can come to school in their trainers **but must have clean pumps to change into for use in the PE hal** these can be left on their peg for the half term. All jewellery should be removed on PE days including earrings.
