

Maths

In Maths, children will explore fractions by learning to identify and find whole fractions, halves, thirds, and quarters. They will understand the difference between unit fractions and non-unit fractions. Additionally, we will practice telling the time, focusing on reading clocks accurately and understanding concepts like hours, minutes, and seconds.

Science

In Science this term we will be looking at the growth and survival of animals, including humans. We will be learning about the basic needs of animals, including humans and the importance of exercise. We will also be learning about life cycles and how we grow.

English

This half term we will be focusing on The King who Banned the Dark. We will be writing a persuasive letter to the king to persuade him to not ban the dark. Within this unit we will be focusing on suffixes, compound words, adverbs, subordinating conjunctions, coordinating conjunctions and expanded noun phrases.

History

In History, we will be researching The Great Fire of London. We will be learning when, where and why the fire happened. We will also be exploring how the fire has impacted life for us today and how it would be different if the fire happened today.

Summer Term 1

PHSE

This half term we will be learning about different relationships. We will first be focusing on different families and how some families might be different from ours. We will then be exploring the different relationships that we have with our friends.

PE

In PE, one of our units is Dance Unit 2, where we be learning how to perform a short dance showing different emotions and moods.

We will also be continuing to learn different ball skills in Send and Return Unit 2. We will learn to send the ball to specific areas in a court. We will also develop our throwing and catching skills.

RE

We will be learning about and comparing different religions. Within this, we will be comparing different religious buildings and traditions. We will be looking at the religions of Christianity, Islam and Sikhism.

DT/Art/Computing

This half term in DT we will be completing a mechanics unit. We will be learning to make a moving monster. This will involve designing a moving monster, selecting appropriate materials, assembling the monster using the correct linkages and evaluating their final piece.

We will also be completing a textiles unit which will involve sewing a running stitch, preparing and cutting fabric and designing their pouch.

In computing, we will be learning about the International Space Station. In this unit we will develop our knowledge of spreadsheets and understanding that data can be inputted into a spreadsheet. We will use data to ask questions and make interpretations. We will explore how computers are used in the wider world.

Music

In Music, our topic is Myths and legends. In this unit, children will be looking at how to structure music. In music lessons, the children will be reading and clapping out rhythms from a story, writing their own rhythms and composing their own music using rhythmic patterns based on a legend or myth. At the end of the unit, the children will be performing a group composition they have created to the rest of the class.
