

Maths

We will continue to learn about Multiplication and division. We will start by looking at grouping objects and then we will move onto the 2, 5, 10 times table. We will also look at doubling and halving and at the relationship between multiplication and division. We will then move onto measurement where we will be exploring length and height, and mass, capacity, and temperature.

Geography

We will continue learning about weather and climate. We will move on from learning about the UK and begin to look at the rest of the world. We will also learn about the equator and the northern and southern hemisphere and look at how this impacts the climate.

PHSE

In PSHE this term we will be focusing on the topic of healthy me. We will be learning about different ways to stay healthy including healthy eating and exercise. We will also learn about medicine safety and how to relax and why this is important.

PE

Run, Jump, Throw Unit 1

Within this topic, we will be focusing on athletics. We will be exploring the best techniques to use when running in races, throwing objects to targets and jumping.

Gymnastics Unit 2

We will be focusing on creating a sequence of movements using different balances and movements that have been previously learnt.

Science

In Science this term we will continue to learn about Living Things and Their Habitats. We will consolidate our learning about animal adaptations and this enables them to survive. We will end our unit by answering the question 'How are animals suited to their environment?'

RE

This half term we will be learning about salvation. We will begin by looking at the different kinds of peace. We will then look at how Jesus' teachings influence how Christians live today, how they show their beliefs and why they pray. Within this unit, we will reflect on what friendship, forgiveness and peace means to us.

English

This half term we will be reading the story Grandad's Island and we will be writing a narrative and an information text. The Grammar that we will be working on will be; suffixes (er, est, ly), expanded noun phrases, questions and exclamations, past and present tense and apostrophes for possession.

In Spring 2, we'll be exploring Traditional Tales and Poetry. In this exciting unit, the children will read 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs' by Jon Scieszka which retells the traditional tale from the wolf's perspective. We'll make inferences based on what we have read and think carefully about how the wolf felt about the three little pigs. Additionally, we'll be looking at Roald Dahl's poetry book, 'Revolting Rhymes'. This is an exciting poetry book which gives a re-interpretation of six well-known fairy tales and we'll be retrieving key information to help us answer questions about what we have read.

DT

In DT this half term we will be learning about a balanced diet. This topic will involve learning about the main food groups and identifying foods in each group. The children will also be planning and making their own healthy wrap.

As well as this, the children will be learning about structures. The children will be learning how to identify man-made and natural structures, stable and unstable structural shapes and features that make a chair stable. The children will then design and make a chair suitable for Baby Bear.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about the International Space Station. In this unit we will develop our knowledge of spreadsheets and understanding that data can be inputted into a spreadsheet. We will use data to ask questions and make interpretations. We will explore how computers are used in the wider world.

Music

In Music, we will continue our Myths and Legends topic. We will play and write rhythms with one beats and paired half beats and read and follow a structure from left to right. We will learn to work well as part of a group, listening to others and respecting their ideas.
